

I believe that the title of the congress 'Vision to Reality - the project management way' is most appropriate for the development of business and societies facing the challenges of the 21st century.



GPM - the German Association for Project Management in cooperation with IPMA are the founders and promoters of the Award which is now supported by 120 Assessors from 20 IPMA National Member Associations. An unique opportunity for international visibility.

The IPMA International Award Jury decides the award which will be disclosed during the Award Gala on 15 November 2005 in New Delhi.

1st Conference of Asia Pacific Federation for PM (Nov 10-11, 2005)

The Asia Pacific Federation for Project Management (APFPM) has been created to strengthen the PM foundation in the Asia Pacific Region by promoting communications and co-operation between Asia Pacific organisations, professionals, associations and senior level Government officials in the Asia Pacific belt.

Though independent of the IPMA World Congress, the first Conference of Asia Pacific Federation for PM is being held on Nov.10-11, 2005 to provide delegates an additional opportunity to participate in the other global events.

This two day meet of PM leaders and experts will contribute to the growing PM discipline in the region through presentations of major areas of PM research, standards, education and certification.

Call for Papers

We invite you to submit a high-quality abstract followed later by the final paper for your presentation at the congress. Your paper/contribution should focus on one of the 5 Congress Streams and a Section within a Stream.

The following submission guidelines have been prepared to help ensure the uniformity of the presentation and the quality of the final documentation:

- The official congress language is English.
- Papers and presentations should be free of commercial sales content.
- Papers and presentations should focus on the subject of the title, and preferably provide new contribution to the topic.
- The length of the *abstract* should be between 300 to 400 words.
- Abstracts shall be typed in '12 pt Times New Roman' font in the MS-Word format 6.0 or later version.
- · Each abstract must have a lead author who will serve as the primary contact for all correspondence.

When submitting the abstract for consideration, the lead author needs to provide the following additional information:

- Title of the paper
- Name of lead author and other author'(s)
- Up to 5 bullet points summarizing the content
- · Author(s) affiliations and a short biography
- · Lead author's postal address, phone, fax and email address
- · Company/Institution's name and address

Length of the final paper should be between 2000 and 3000 words, with additional up to four A4 size paper for appendices and graphics. Together with the submission of the abstract itself the author permits publishing of the accepted paper on the Internet and in the Congress documentation.
